

SUNNYSIDE CAMP 2023 INFORMATION

CAMP DROP-OFF/PICK-UP TIMES

- Senior High Camp
 - Check-in: Sunday, August 6, 2023, 2:00pm - 4:00pm
 - Pick-up: Friday, August 11, 2023, 7:00pm - 8:00pm
- Junior High Camp
 - Check-in: Sunday, August 13, 2023, 2:00pm - 4:00pm
 - Pick-up: Friday, August 18, 2023, 7:00pm - 8:00pm
- Pre-teen Camp
 - Check-in: Sunday, August 20, 2023, 2:00pm - 4:00pm
 - Pick-up: Thursday August 24, 2023, 3:00pm - 4:00pm

**IMPORTANT CHECK-IN DETAILS

- Registration starts Sunday afternoon at 2:00pm (**no earlier**) and ends at 4:00pm.
- *Please do not arrive before 2:00pm as we will not start registering until that time.*
- Upon arrival, please sign-in at the front desk of the main building.
- During and after registration, a variety of activities and a camp orientation are planned.
- Please advise us prior to 12:00pm on check-in day if you will be arriving after 4:00pm.
- Be prepared to confirm the name of the person who will be picking up your child(ren), we **will** ask for ID upon pick-up.
- There will be no accommodation changes onsite, assigned rooms are final.

CAMPER PICK UP

Upon arrival, parents will:

- Sign out campers at the registration desk in the cafe.
- Receive check out slips for each camper.
- Meet Security prior to leaving to confirm check out slips.
- All campers must be signed out between:
 - Senior High Camp and Junior High Camp: 7:00pm and 8:00pm on Friday
 - Pre-teen Camp: 3:00pm - 4:00pm on Thursday

**IMPORTANT PICK-UP DETAILS

- Parents are invited to participate in a closing service:
 - Senior High Camp and Junior High Camp: 6:15pm-7:15pm
 - Pre-teen Camp: 2:00pm - 3:00pm.
- Please arrange for pickup in advance. Designated Drivers will be required to show ID at pick-up to verify identity. Students **MUST** be picked up on time.

REQUIRED FORMS & DOCS

- You will be required to print off the waivers and bring them with your son/daughter at the time of registration. If you are planning alternate arrangements for drop-off other than

yourself, please send the signed waiver with your child. If signed waivers are not provided, your child will NOT be allowed to stay at camp.

MEALS

- Children will be served three meals a day starting with Sunday supper.
- If your child has any severe food allergies not noted on the registration form, please contact us at info@sunnyside.camp

TUCK SHOP

- Following the evening sessions, campers will be able to purchase snacks and drinks.
- Tuck shop is not included in the registration fee. If your child would like to buy anything from the tuck shop, he/she will have to bring extra cash for the week. \$35-\$50 is recommended; however, this is dependent on your child's daily spending.

MEDICATIONS

- All medications will be collected at registration by the camp nurse and will be dispensed by the camp nurse during the week as per parent's instructions.
- All medications need to be in the original containers with the labels still on them.
- Campers with asthma inhalers may carry these with them if required.
- By registering for the camp, you are giving consent to our first aid staff to provide basic, over-the-counter medications to your camper when needed. If you have concerns, please contact us.

PHONE CALLS

- A phone will be made available for use by campers during free time from 4pm-5pm Sunday-Thursday. For their own safety campers may only call numbers listed as contacts on their registration form.
- Other than during this time (4pm-5pm), camp phones are only for use in emergencies.
- We require that students' leave their cell phones at home so they can fully engage at camp.
- If you need to get a hold of your camper, email info@sunnyside.camp for the fastest response.
- If parents have any emergencies, please contact Sunnyside Camp at **(587) 971 - 4069** and/or email the Youth Camp Administrator at info@sunnyside.camp and leave a message with your name, your camper's name, a call-back number, and the reason for your call.

HYGIENE

- All campers will be required to shower (with soap and shampoo), to brush their teeth each morning and evening and to disinfect their hands with hand sanitizer prior to each meal.
- Private showers are available for all campers.
- Please provide a clean set of clothing for each day of camp.

VISITORS

- To ensure the safety and securing of all campers and staff, no visitors are allowed on camp property without camp director/administrator's consent. Parental visits are allowed if needed but should be planned in advance.
- Upon arrival, please speak with a staff member. They will register you and provide you with a visitor pass.
- Campers cannot be taken out of activities and/or offsite unless you are signing them out for the remainder of the week, unless you have prior written approval from the Camp Director/Administrator/Coordinator.
- We are unable to provide visitors with meals.
- Please email us (info@sunnyside.camp) at least 1 day ahead of your planned arrival or let us know of your plans at camper drop-off.

SUNSCREEN AND MOSQUITO REPELLANT

- Please ensure your camper packs their own supply of sunscreen and mosquito repellent. If needed the camp has sunscreen and/or mosquito repellent available for campers prior to and during outdoor activities at the first aid station.
- We remind campers daily to apply sunscreen prior to activities; however, we cannot be responsible if they choose not to.
- If your child has any allergies or reactions to sunscreen or mosquito repellent, please advise the nurse at registration and provide appropriate alternatives.

ALLERGIES

- Upon request, with advanced notice, Sunnyside Camp may be able to provide alternative meal options for those with severe restrictive food allergies. All campers with food allergies must be confident in determining which dishes in the buffet may contain allergens, as buffet service is not supervised. And questions about the ingredients of particular dishes can be directed to the Leadership Team Leader at the time of service. Parents of campers with severe allergies are also encouraged to send special food and snacks with their camper (i.e., breakfast items for campers with celiac disease). A fridge and freezer are available onsite for this purpose.
